

Testing Schedule for the 2017-2018 school year:

Sixth Grade:

- M-STEP
 - Test window April 30-May25
 - Subjects tested
 - English Language Arts
 - Math

Seventh Grade:

- M-STEP
 - Test window April 30 –May 25
 - Subjects tested
 - English Language Arts
 - Math

Eighth Grade

- M-STEP
 - Test window April 9 – April 4
 - Subjects tested
 - English Language Arts
 - Math
 - Social Studies
 - Science (pilot test)

Freshmen:

- PSAT 8/9
 - Test Date April 10th OR April 11th
 - All Freshman will be taking the PSAT test this year. The PSAT test assists students in preparing for the SAT.

Sophomore:

- PSAT 10 Test
 - Test Date April 10th OR April 11th
 - All Sophomores will be taking the PSAT test this year. The PSAT test assists students in preparing for the SAT.

Juniors:

- SAT-MME
 - SAT Tuesday April 10th
 - WorkKeys Wednesday April 11th
 - Michigan Science and Social Studies Thursday April 12th
- ASVAB (see description in seniors)
- PSAT/NMSQT Wednesday October 14
 - \$15 charge for taking this test
 - students will get feedback about critical academic skills , enter scholarship competitions, and initiate the college-planning process

Seniors:

- ASVAB
 - Tuesday October 6th
 - The ASVAB was originally designed to predict future academic and occupational success in military occupations
 - Now ASVAB uses several composite scores are formed from different combinations of ASVAB test scores. Three composites, or Career Exploration Scores, are provided specifically to help students engage in career exploration.
- SAT-MME
 - Seniors who did not take the MME in their Junior year are able to take the test with the Juniors in March
