Review Weekly 2-Way Interaction (Attendance) Rates for Elementary (K-5)

Staff Comments: Some elementary teachers have indicated that they would encourage consideration of a plan to serve some hot breakfast options.

Reconfirm how instruction (Return to Learn Plan) is going to be delivered during the 20/21 school year:

We will continue to follow the adopted 2020-21 Extended Learning Plan and offer K-12 Face To Face instruction with an option for remote instruction as needed. 9th - 12th graders just returned to the In Person option on January 4, 2021.

Reconfirm whether or not the district is offering higher levels of in-person instruction for English language learners, special education students, or other special populations:

All K-8 student populations have the same options at this time (in person, distance or virtual). All Special Education students have had a Contingency Learning Plan (CLP) completed that specifies how their needs will be met if they are attending remotely.
