Attendance Concerns

Attendance is important to academic gains. Make sure your child is attending school regularly. If your child needs to miss school make sure to excuse them within two school days. Provide a medical slip if you can.

Make up time: Students who miss more than 5 class periods will need to make up 30 minutes per hour missed. Excused and unexcused absences count toward make up time. Funeral, Doctor or Health Department verified absence, or pre-excused absences do not count towards make up time.



Tutoring Services On campus and On line.

After school tutoring is available for students in grades 6-12 from 3:30-4:30 Monday through Thursday. Grades 6-8 meet with Mrs. Grentz in Room 302 and Grades 9-12 meet with Mr. Moore in Room 316. No prior appointment is needed-Students can just show up for homework help.
